| 2 | Small scale business most appropriate |
| 2 | Encourage renewable energy as part of business development, include PV (solar) panels on or around industrial buildings. Wind turbines of a sensible size and location, even a small wind farm would be welcome. |
| 2 | Manor Farm B&B and venue are good businesses to have in the village |
| 2 | There is a demand for Nursery / pre-school / play group / child-care facility. The village hall receives regular requests from parental hirers for this type of use. |
| 1 | There is sufficient large-scale business development already |
| 1 | Retirement home on Station Road is a good business to have in the village |
| 1 | Concentrate industrial activity in particular locations |
| 1 | Light commercial not always compatible with residential, noise etc. |
| 1 | Home businesses can be disruptive if they result in significant traffic of people or goods at a residential address. |
| 1 | People working close to home is good for all. Can't guarantee that jobs will be taken by locals but important to have employment in the area so that this is a possibility. |
| 1 | The village hall could be extended and altered to allow more use and to diversify use. For example, child-care requires different access arrangements for toilets to avoid children having to be accompanied in the entrance hall because it is not secured against unauthorised access. |
